

## Spring 2022 Teaching Faculty Position at SNU

The College English Program(CEP) of the Faculty of Liberal Education at Seoul National University is hiring a qualified full-time instructor to teach College English courses for the university's undergraduate students from Spring 2022.

### Period of Employment

March 1, 2022–February 28, 2023. The contract is renewable.

### Qualifications

1. Native speaker of English
2. A master's or higher degree
3. Four or more years of teaching/research experience at secondary and/or postsecondary level (the time spent for postgraduate degrees [MA, PhD, etc.] will be counted towards teaching/research experience)
4. Candidates from all areas of specialization will be considered, although preference may be given to those with EFL-related credentials and teaching experience at the college level.

### Job Description

1. Teaching twelve class hours per week (usually four courses) in each of the two fifteen-week semesters
2. Teaching one summer or winter session course per year for overtime payment
3. Performing teaching-related duties requested by the College English Program and participating regularly in faculty meetings and workshops.

### Salary

The annual salary starts from 43,000,000 KRW.

### Housing

Full-time instructors with foreign citizenship are eligible to apply for the stay in on-campus apartment. Monthly rent varies between 398,000 KRW (studio apartment) and 630,000 KRW (two-bedroom apartment).

1. All undergraduate and graduate academic diplomas and transcripts\* [Academic Information]
2. Official records of all previous employment (including information on the actual periods of employment) [Career Information]
3. Statement of purpose (including brief biography) [Personal Introduction]
4. Teaching and research statement [Personal Introduction-Education and Research Plan]
5. List of academic publications (including books, book chapters, journal publications, translations, etc. that have been published) [Other Documents]
6. Two recommendation letters (desirably, including one from your previous employer either in English or in Korean) [Other Documents]
7. A photocopy of the passport ID page [Other Documents]

\* Title of thesis /dissertation and the name of academic advisor should be stated. Final candidates will be requested to bring the original copies of all the documents submitted (diplomas and transcripts, official records of employment) to the interview for verification purposes.

### Deadline and Contacts:

The online application should be completed by 6:00 p.m. (Korean Standard Time) on November 12, 2021.

Final candidates will be contacted by November 30, 2021 to schedule an interview and demonstration lecture.
