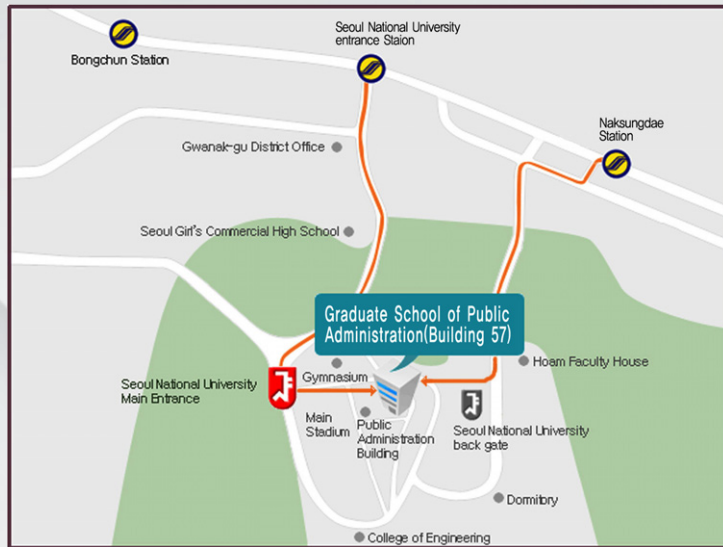


KJPS-SNU & GigaNet Regional Conference on Internet Governance MAP
